Title of the Practice:

Aims:

Mission:

Objectives:

- i. To make everyone aware regarding the importance of hygienic life.
- ii. To raise awareness among employees and students about the need to reduce the consumption of goods and services that cause pollution.
- iii. To organize events, rallies, tree planting drives, field trips, educational tours, and other activities to raise awareness of environmental concerns.
- iv. To educate workers and students about the environment so they may speak out against dangerous activities that endanger it.
- v. Steps to be made in order to develop human morals and values through the implementation of a nature-awareness program.
- vi. To guarantee a plastic-free environment on college campuses.
- vii. Prohibiting the use of alcoholic beverages on college property.
- viii. To advertise on-campus gardens.
- ix. To ensure the use of LED bulbs and Tubes within the college campus.
- x. Awareness for controlling of sound pollution within the campus.
- xi. Proper management for dropping solid wastes.
- xii. Restriction on high polluted vehicles within the college campus.
- xiii. Use of Dustbin.

Implementation:

The following measures are taken for the implementation of Green Campus:

- (i) In front of the college building, the Green Campus Committee's policies are on display.
- (ii) The College appoints a person to see the matters of cleanliness whose remuneration is funded by the college.

- (iii) The designated campus cleaner has been carrying out his responsibilities on a regular basis, which include keeping the restrooms, classrooms, and campus as a whole clean.
- (iv) The trash is guaranteed to fall in the designated spot in the college campus's corner.
- (v) Two solar lights are installed.
- (vi) Two drinking water filters with cooler of good quality are installed.
- (vii) Garbage dumps are arranged for wastages and garbage at the corner of the college campus.
- (viii) All significant days are commemorated to preserve and enhance the environment in an effort to raise awareness of nature among all people.
- (ix) Green environment planting is being done both on and off campus at the college.
- (x) The college administration proclaims the campus to be plastic-free.
- (xi) If students engage in any unlawful or immoral behavior, including ragging or gender discrimination, the administration will not tolerate it.
- (xii) The establishment and upkeep of a garden on the college campus are guaranteed.
- (xiii) There is a guaranteed water exit.
- (xiv) Vehicles with high pollution levels are subject to restrictions on college campuses.
- (xv) To guarantee a pollution-free environment, over 60% of students and employees go to college by public bus, electric car, bicycle, and non-polluting vehicles.























"Meri Maati Mera Desh" From 9th August to 15th August 2023 Programme Participation By NSS Unit Progati College, Agomani



Aims:

- (v) The Advisory Board assists the Editorial Board in choosing the articles.
- (vi) After being given to the students, the college magazines are posted on the website of the college.
- (vii) The Wall Magazine is prominently exhibited on the magazine board for public viewing.
- (viii) Only the authors of the articles receive access to the research volumes; some are also retained for students to peruse in the college library.
