The College got final Govt. Concurrence in 1998. In 2013 the College has been provincialised by the Govt. of Assam. The Collegeoffers course under Gauhati University (Assam).

In the end the College regards its gratitude to the intelectual directors, workers, doners and guides who took steps first to found the College. The College also express its hearty wishes to the 7 (Seven) first admitted students in the College.

 2. Arts students with Geography as a subject will have to pay an additional amount of Rs. 400.00 for the degree course as laboratory Fees.
 3. T.D.C students will have to pay online the registration and enrolment under G.U. Students selected for honours courses will have to pay an additional amount of Rs.680.00 fro Arts-stream.
 4. Candidates / Guardians are requested to bring the exact amount of Fees for admission, if applicable.
 5. Registration forms must be submitted asper the G.U. notification from the date of admission failing which stdents will not be able to appear in the Final Examination.
 6. Once a student is admitted, Fee will not be refunded.
 7. Seat will be forfeited if a student remains absent from classes for 20 days after the commencement of the session.

Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in Undergraduate Course under Gauhati University :

The Gauhati University has introduced CBCS system in UG courses with effect from the academic session 2019-20. There are six semesters in UG courses over a period of three calendar years. The schedule for the semester system is as follows :

In Semester-II Environmental Science (Ability Enhancement Course) is compulsory for students of all programmes. For further details one may visit Gauhati University website, www.gauhati.ac.in. A student's performance in the CBCS semester system shall be monitored throughout the semester by continuous assessment in both theory and practical papers. Evaluation in each theory and practical paper will be as follows:

Internal evaluation shall be based on sessional examinations, home assignments, seminars, class attendance etc. in each semester while external evaluation shall be through a final examination at the end of the semester conducted by Gauhati University. Students must secure pass marks in both internal and external examinations separately. **Students must have minimum 75% class attendance for appearing the examination.**

Students' Code of Conduct

1. It is obligatory for all students to wear the prescribed college uniform. Students not wearing proper uniform will be refused entry into the college campus.
2. Students must carry their college identity cards at all times inside the college campus. In case of its loss or damage, the college authority should be informed immediately.
3. Students must be regular and punctual in attending classes. It is to be noted that at least 75% attendance is necessary for appearing in Council and University examinations.
4. Loitering in the corridors is not permitted.
5. Smoking and chewing of tobacco is strictly prohibited inside the college campus.
6. Ignorance of rules will not be accepted as an excuse for their non-observance.
7. Ragging in any form inside the college and hostel campus is strictly prohibited. Students involved in this act will be punished severely as per the directives of the Honorable Supreme Court.
8. Cleanliness should be maintained at all cost. Waste materials should be disposed off in the waste bins kept for the purpose. Writing and sticking of bill on walls and spitting on walls are strictly prohibited.
9. **All students should read the notice in the notice board and visit the website regularly.**

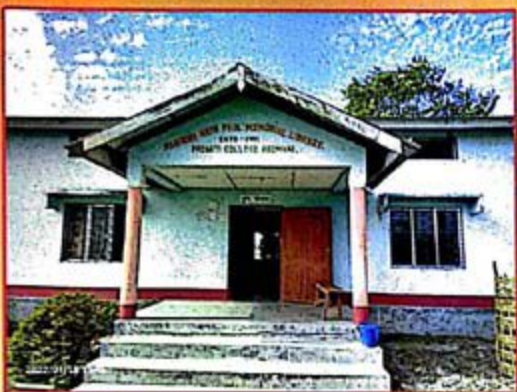
