In the begining only 7 (Seven) Students were admited in the College.


Now the College bears more then thousand annolment every year.

- 5. Registration forms must be submited asper the G.U. notification from the date of admission failing which stdents will not be able to appear in the Final Examination.
- 6. Once a student is admitted, Fee will not be refunded.
- 7. Seat will be forfeited if a student remains absent from classes for 20 days after the commencement of the session.
- 8. Library caution money will be refunded after the lapse of two yeras from the date of complition of the course.

General Information to students :-

Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in Undergraduate Course under Gauhati University:

The Guwahati University has introduced CBSC system in UG courses with effect from the academic session 2019-20. There are six semesters in UG courses over a period of three calender years. The schedule for the semester system is as follows:

First, third and fifth semester (including examination) : August to December Second, fourth and sixth semester (including examination) : January to June
In CBSC, broadly there are two programs : 1. B.A. (Honours)
2. B.A. (Regular)

The details of B.A. / B.Sc. (Honours and Regular) programme for Semester-I are as follow:

Programme	Subjects to be taken:
B.A. (Honours)	One subject (Core course), English/MIL communication and one General Elective (GE) subject (Core course and GE must be two different subjects)
B.A. (Regular)	English-1, English/MIL communication and Two Discipline Specific Courses (subjects)

In Semester-II Environmental Science (Ability Enhancement Course) is compulsory for students of all programmes. For further details one may visit Gauhati University website, www.gauhati.ac.in. A student's performance in the CBCS semester system shall be monitored throughout the semester by continuous assessment in both theory and practical papers. Evaluation in each theory and practical paper will be as follows:

Internal evaluation : 20% marks (includes sessional examinations)

External evaluation : 80% marks

Internal evaluation shall be based on sessional examinations, home assignments, seminars, class attendance etc. in each semester while external evaluation shall be through a final examination at the end of the semester conducted by Gauhati University. Students must secure pass marks in both internal and external examinations separately. Students must have minimum 75% class attendance for appearing the examination.

Students' Code of Conduct

- It is obligatory for all students to wear the prescribed college uniform.
 Students not wearing proper uniform will be refused entry into the college campus.
- Students must carry their college identity cards at all times inside the college campus. In case of its loss or damage, the college authority should be informed immediately.
- Students must be regular and punctual in attending classes. It is to be noted that at least 75% attendance is necessary for appearing in Council and University examinations.
- 4. Loitering in the corridors is not permitted.
- Smoking and chewing of tobacco is strictly prohibited inside the college campus.
- Ignorance of rules will not be accepted as an excuse for their non-observance.

- Ragging in any from inside the college and hostel campus in strictly prohibited. Students involved in this act will be punished severely as per the directives of the Honorable Supreme Court.
- 8. Cleanliness should be maintained al all cost. Waste materials should be disposed off in the waste bins kept for the purpose. Writing and sticking of bill on walls and spitting on walls are strictly prohibited.
- All students should read the notice in the notice board and visit the website regularly.


